## A Pastoral Word

### *Surfing the Edge...*

On Sunday, May 22nd, Midway Christian Church voted to participate in the regionally sponsored process of Surfing the Edge which is an 18 month process where we intentionally listen and look for what God is up to in our neighborhoods and communities. As part of this process, Midway Christian will select a Guiding Team that will help direct this process in our church. This Guiding Team will get together every 3 months with other churches' guiding teams to share stories about what God is doing and work with the CCK staff as resources and coaches through this process. Along our journey, they will assess what we've learned and plan out our next steps. Shirley Eckels, Jim Leer, Etta Manor, Sheri Adkins have agreed to serve as our guiding team. I ask that we all keep them in our thoughts and prayers along this journey.

Also during this 18-month process, one of the steps we will be asking the congregation to take is to complete surveys on-line which are called Congregation 360. These will give us an overview of our congregation as a resource for dialogue for where we see ourselves in regards to readiness for the missional church. I will also be taking an on-line survey as your pastor called Pastor 360 which will be a resource for me for dialogue regarding being a missional leader.

Look for more updates to come from the guiding team starting after the first of June but in the meantime, please feel free to do some research on your own about Alan Roxburgh, the consultant and the Missional church by going to [www.roxburghmissionalnet.com](http://www.roxburghmissionalnet.com). ## Gift from Jeanette Atkinson Estate

In April, the church received news that we had received a bequest left to the church by Jeannette Atkinson who was a member of Midway Christian Church in the 80's and 90's until transferring her membership to a church in Lexington.



Because of this wonderful donation and legacy given to Midway Christian Church by Mrs. Atkinson, the trustees have decided to use the funds to complete certain projects around the church:

1. Fund proposed Capital projects including moving playground fence in order to access the southwest wall and roof of the sanctuary (Library) for cleaning and repairing box gutters and roof.
2. If any money remains after the above project is completed, use it for the kitchen certification project.
3. Since "Surfing the Edge" was approved by the congregation, the \$2000 fee will be paid through this fund.
4. If any money which remains is not needed for the kitchen project, return that money to the Capital fund.

## Trustee News

At the January 23, 2011 meeting of the Trustees, we made the decision to make available \$4000 from the Endowment Fund as specified in the policy. Three written requests were received from the congregation for outreach related improvements, equipment or mission programs, not already included in the church annual budget. The Trustees recommend the following grants for the \$4000 withdrawal from the Endowment Fund:

1. Certification of Church Kitchen    **\$2500**
2. "Week of Wonder", an adult work camp at Christmount, for 4 adults    **\$560**
3. Green Chalice request for bike rack to be located on Midway Christian Church property    **\$500**
4. Any funds remaining from the \$4000 after granting the above requests will be allocated to the certification of the church kitchen

### June Mission Payment

**Camp Wakon Da Ho** is one of two Christian Church in KY camp sites that host regional camps for the youth of our region. It is located in Casey County, KY. Each summer, children and youth gather from across the state of Kentucky to experience church camp and to grow in their relationship with God. For many years, Midway Christian has supported Camp Wakon' Da-Ho by making a financial donation and by sending youth and children to camp.

**Disciples Mission Fund** builds a foundation enabling Disciples to globally share the good news of Jesus Christ. This common fund allows the Disciples to pool their resources accomplishing a greater ministry. One congregation could not achieve this alone. Disciples Mission Fund allows a process of whole church stewardship supporting God-given missions at home and world-wide. They live their theological understanding of Christ's prayer "that they all may be one." As a faithful growing church, Disciples demonstrate true sense of community, deep Christian spirituality and a passion for justice.

### Emergency Clean Up Buckets

We are still collecting Emergency Clean-up Buckets, which will enable people to begin the overwhelming job of cleaning up. You can supply an entire bucket, bring items to fill one, or donate \$56 to cover the cost of a bucket. Items needed:

- One five-gallon bucket with resealable lid
- Five scouring pads
- Seven sponges, assorted sizes
- One scrub brush
- Eighteen cleaning towels (reusable, like Easy Wipes)
- One 50-78 oz. box dry laundry detergent
- One 12 oz. bottle of liquid cleaner (Lysol, Mr. Clean, etc.)
- One 25 oz. dish soap (Dawn, Joy, etc.)
- One package of 48-50 clothespins
- Clothesline, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.
- Five dust masks
- Two pairs latex gloves
- One pair work gloves
- Heavy-duty trash bags, 3-45 gallon size
- One 6-9 oz. bottle of insect repellent

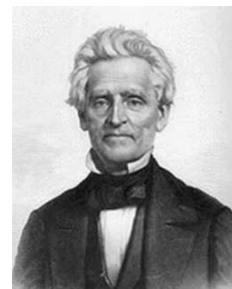
