

## Proposal for Withdrawal from Endowment Funds

In 2016, Midway Christian Church installed much-needed new playground equipment. At that time, the leadership decided to go with equipment used for a personal backyard. We did this for a variety of factors, but the main one was cost. In the last six years, that playground equipment has been used a lot. It has become an extension of our mission of WELCOME. Many people in our Midway community and from surrounding areas come to use the playground daily.

Unfortunately, the playground equipment was not designed to handle as much use as it has received in the last six years, and it has come to the end of its life span. It has become a liability issue.

In conversation with the Trustees, it was decided that the church needs to invest in new commercial-grade playground equipment which would give us 15-20 years of use.

The Trustees are proposing using \$20,000 from the Endowment Fund to cover the cost of this project:

### Breakdown of Project:

Equipment: \$16,000 (includes tear down of old set and installation for the new set)

Equipment for younger children: \$226.59

New Mulch: \$2000

Dumpster Rental (for removing old equipment): \$1000

6 foot bench (bottlecaps): \$340

Possibly adding another swing set, reusing the swings from previous set: \$400

Total: \$19,966.59

This proposal is the beginning of the process, according to our Endowment Fund policy which states:

*"If extenuating circumstances occur, additional withdrawals may be made from the Endowment Fund of Midway Christian Church. The approval of an additional withdrawal is required by three-fourths of the total church Board at two successive meetings, upon published written description of the proposed withdrawal, sent to the Board members at least two weeks prior to the first meeting. Board members may vote by proxy via e-mail or the church's automated telephone system. Reasons for an additional withdrawal may include a catastrophic event such as fire, tornado or flood that directly affect the church."*
