New Worship Series: Starts Sunday, June 4th Quest: Awakened Traveler

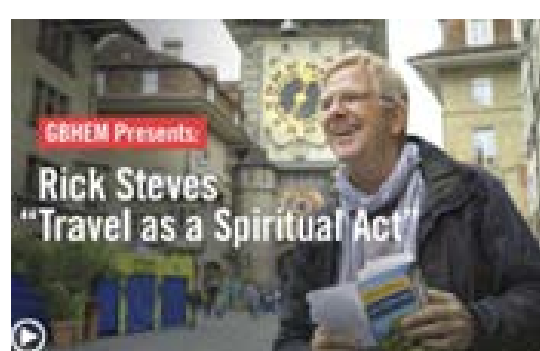

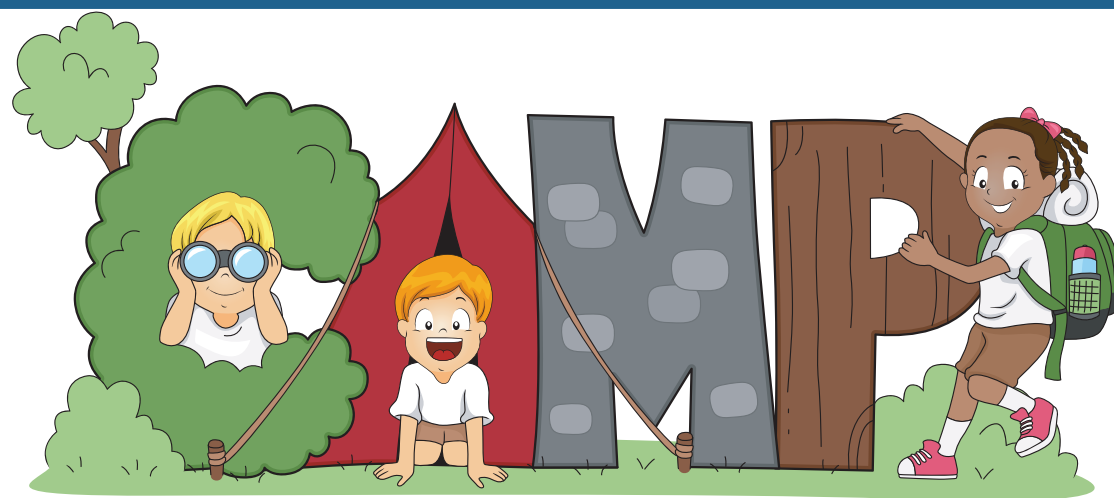
