For Scott, an understanding of God's love would reveal to people the error of their ways and motivate them to change.

Title: "Freedom to Follow"

Jesus has begun his journey to Jerusalem and encounters people along the way who have closed their hearts to Jesus in various ways. They have the freedom to follow Jesus, but have become "slaves" to various parts of their lives which prevents them from following Jesus.

June 24, 2007

Scripture: 1 Kings 21: 1-21

Title: "Possession of the Vineyard"

King Ahab decides that he wants his neighbor's vineyard for his own and asks for this vineyard but is refused. His wife, Jezebel, develops a plot to "acquire" this vineyard which leads to the neighbor's death. Elijah accuses Ahab of his crimes and predicts Ahab's death and demise.

June 17, 2007

Scripture: 1 Kings 19: 1-4, 8-15

Title: "The Sound of Silence"

Jezebel has threatened Elijah with taking his life in retaliation for killing the prophets of Baal. Elijah runs away but God comes to Elijah. There is a strong wind, but God is not in the wind. There is an earthquake, but God is not in the earthquake. There is a fire, but God is not in the fire. God comes to Elijah in the silence.

June 10, 2007

Scripture: 1 Kings 17: 8-16

Title: "The jar will be not emptied"

This is the story of Elijah who has been commanded by God to travel to Zarephath and to await for a widow to feed him. Elijah travels to this city and does meet the widow. The widow explains that she does not have enough food for him and her family. Elijah gives her the good news of the promises of God.

This is John's account of the resurrection. Mary Magdalene comes to the tomb early in the morning and sees that the stone has been rolled away. She runs to Simon Peter and the other disciple and brings them back to the tomb. They discover that the tomb is empty and leave. Mary stays behind and encounters the risen Lord and shares the Good News with the disciples.

April 1, 2007 (Palm Sunday)

Scripture: Luke 19: 28-40

Title: "Blessed is the King"

This is Luke's account of Jesus' Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem. Jesus enters the city on a colt and met by a crowd of people who spread their cloaks on the road. The disciples begin to say, "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord!" Some of the Pharisees wanted Jesus to tell his disciples to be quiet, but Jesus says that even if they were quiet, the stones would shout out.

Scripture: Luke 13: 31-35

Title: "The Fox and the Hen"

On his way to Jerusalem, Jesus is stopped by some Pharisees who share that Herod wants to kill Jesus. Jesus speaks out against this "fox" and cries for the city Jerusalem, understanding that even Jesus cannot prevent the death of the protective "hen."

Scripture: Luke 4: 1-13

Title: "The Fine Print"

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 3:12-4:2

Title: "Lights On!"

Paul responds to the Corinthians' request for a "letter of recommendation" stating that the community at Corinth is its own letter of recommendation for how God works in people's lives.

Scripture: Luke 6: 17-26

Title: "Blessings and Woes"

This is sometimes called the Sermon on the Plain. Jesus begins his public teaching and healing ministry. He sets out his vision for the new world and how things are in the Kingdom of God.

Scripture: Luke 5:1-11

Title: "From Now On"

Jesus boards Simon's boat and begins to teach the crowd that has gathered around the lake Gennesaret. Jesus tells Simon to put his nets down in the water again, but Simon explains that they have been fishing all night and didn't catch anything. Simon follows Jesus' command and their nets begin to break because there are so many fishes. This is the beginning of the disciples' ministry with Jesus.

January 28, 2007

Scripture: John 2: 1-11

Title: "Do whatever he tells you"

This is the story of the wedding at Cana. Mary comes to Jesus and says that the family is out of wine. Jesus tells Mary that it is not time but he proceeds to turn water into wine.

January 21, 2007

Scripture: Luke 4: 14-30

Title: "Run out of town"

Jesus comes to his home region of Nazareth and begins his "preaching" ministry. Needless, his synagogue was not too thrilled at his sermon and his claiming to fulfill the prophecy from Isaiah. So they run him out of town.

January 14, 2007

Scripture: Luke 3: 15-17, 21-22

Title: "Baptism by Water and by the Spirit"

This is the story of the baptism of Jesus according to the Gospel of Luke. John the Baptist begins his ministry of pointing the way to Jesus. And all the Gospel of Luke shares about Jesus' baptism is that he was baptized and the Holy Spirit descended upon him like a dove.

Mary has set out to visit Elizabeth and immediately, the babe in Elizabeth's womb recognizes the child that Mary is carrying. Elizabeth calls Mary blessed among women and Mary responds in what is now known as the Magnificat.

December 17, 2006

Luke 1: 26-38

"Nothing Is Impossible With God"

This is the story of the birth of Jesus foretold. The angel Gabriel comes to Mary and says that she will have a son.

December 10, 2006

Luke 1: 5-25

"What the Lord has done for me"

This is the foretelling of the birth of John the Baptist. Zechariah is a priest in the Temple and receives a visit from Gabriel who tells him that Zechariah and Elizabeth will have a son. Zechariah does not believe him and becomes mute.

December 3, 2006

Jeremiah 33: 14-16

"The Days are Surely Coming"

The prophet Jeremiah foretells of the restoration of the Davidic monarchy. This new king will bring justice and righteousness for all.

November 26, 2006

1 Samuel 2: 1-10

"With Thanksgiving"

Hannah takes Samuel to the temple as she promises God. This is her prayer of thanksgiving for God's many blessings for her and her family. Hannah's prayer is reminiscent of Mary's prayer when she hears the good news from the angel.

1 Samuel 1: 4-20

"The power of prayer"

This is the story of Hannah. She is a wife with no sons. She continues to pray for a son but there is no hope. One day while visiting the temple, Eli, the priest, noticed Hannah and scolded her for being drunk in the House of the Lord. Hannah explains that she is not drunk but praying for a son. Eli tells her to go because God had heard her prayer.

November 12, 2006

Ruth 3: 1-5; 4: 13-17

"The Beginning of Something Great!"

This is the continuation of the story of Ruth and Naomi. We learn that Ruth and Boaz marry and have a child. This child is the beginning of something great. Descendants of this family include David and Jesus.

November 5, 2006

Ruth 1: 1-18

"Your people shall be my people"

This is the story of Ruth and Naomi. Naomi's husband and two sons have died and Naomi tells the two daughter-in-laws to go back to their homeland. Ruth refuses and declares that she will stay with Naomi. Her declaration must be understood as an act of *khesed* (showing love and loyalty over and beyond what is considered normal or expected).*

October 29, 2006

Mark 10: 35-45

"Not to be Served But to Serve"

James and John ask Jesus to sit at Jesus' side in his glory. Jesus asks them if they truly understand what they are asking. They answer yes but Jesus knows that they do not understand what he is really asking of them. Jesus reminds them again of his vision and mission for his ministry on earth.

October 22, 2006

Mark 10: 46-52

"What do you want me to do for you?"

Jesus and his disciples came to Jericho as a large crowd was leaving the city. A blind beggar named Bartimaeus calls out to Jesus for healing. Jesus tells some in the crowd to bring Bartimaeus to him and asks what he wants. Bartimaeus asks to be able to see again. Jesus sends him on his way, sight regained and healed.

October 15, 2006

Mark 2:1-12

"Faith in Action"

Jesus returns to Capernaum and people begin to gather. Some people brought a paralyzed man to Jesus to be healed but they were unable to reach Jesus. They decided to cut a hole in the roof and lower the man in to Jesus. Jesus tells the man to stand up and take his mat but there were many in the crowd who questioned Jesus' technique.

Mark 10:17-31

"Then Who Can be Saved?"

Then Jesus continues to explain that he must sell all his possessions and follow Jesus. The young man goes away, sadden by what Jesus says. Jesus explains to his disciples that through God all things are possible.

Mark 9:38-50

"Stumbling Blocks"

The disciples stop someone from casting out demons in Jesus' name and Jesus rebukes their actions. He proceeds to explain what will happen when one does not welcome the "little ones".

September 17, 2006

Mark 8:27-37

"Good Intentions"

Jesus begins to tell the disciples about what will happen to the Son of Man because he will be rejected by the elders and priests. Peter pulls Jesus aside to rebuke Jesus and Jesus rebukes Peter! After this, Jesus continues to teach the crowd about what followers of the Son of Man must do to be saved.

September 10, 2006

Mark 7:31-37

"Be Open"

This is a story about faith and healing. Jesus heals a man who is deaf and mute. He opened up possibilities for this man through this healing but Jesus tells the man to tell no one. However, the word gets out and opens up possibilities for the world!
